#### THE HISTORY

The Prince's Palace at Frederiksholms Kanal in Copenhagen was built by Nicolai Eigtved in 1743-1744 as the residence of Crown Prince Frederik, later Frederik the Fifth.

The building was taken over by the state in 1849, and afterwards extended and used for various purposes, including museum collections, which gave birth to the National Museum in 1892.

The building, which is historically preserved, is one of Denmark's oldest rococo palaces in the French style, and Eigtved's original interior art can still be seen in several places in the main building.

For a time, the Knights' Hall was the studio of painters Jens Juel and N.A. Abildgaard, until it was taken over by the Supreme Court, whose buildings had been destroyed in the fire at Christiansborg in 1794.

Today, many of Denmark's historical treasures are housed within the beautiful buildings. This is why hosting an event with us is the perfect occasion for a tour, an inspiring presentation and a visit to see the collections.





# RESTAURANT SMÖR

On the first floor in the atrium of the National Museum, you find the acclaimed Restaurant Smör.

The cosy restaurant premises can accommodate up to 76 diners, and can offer everything from standing receptions to Christmas parties.

During the day, the restaurant is a lunch restaurant, that you can visit without paying the museums entrance fee.

Restaurant Smör is accessible for events from 6 PM.









## THE ATRIUM

The Museum's 450 m² entrance hall can set the scene for larger events outside of the Museum's opening hours. Here you can host parties or events under the beautiful light of the glass roof.

The Hall is also available for bookings all day on Mondays, when the museum is closed to the public, and can also be combined with the rental of other of our premises.

The Hall is approved for 400 standing people and can fit 280 seated guests at long tables.



## THE BALLROOM


The Ballroom impresses with its breathtaking 225 m² and beautiful columns. This spectacular space therefore adds a little extra to your event.

The Ballroom has modern lighting and sound, and can accommodate 180 people in rows of chairs, 96 people seated at long tables or 220 people for a standing reception.

For dinner parties the Ballroom fits up to 64 people seated at round tables.







## THE GLASS HALL

The Glass Hall is ideal for parties in an intimate setting. The hall's rear glass wall was designed by Aarhus artist Inge Dahl, and gives a stunning light to the atmosphere.

The 162 m² room can accommodate 144 people in rows of chairs, up to 130 people at long tables and 200 people for a standing reception. AV is included.

#### THE CINEMA

The modern 170 m<sup>2</sup> theater is beautifully furnished with lime green Arne Jacobsen seven-foot chairs and a hand-woven backdrop by artist Naja Salto. The Cinema functions as both a theater and an auditorium with sublime technology and a perfect view for everyone.

The Cinema offers 70 m² of stage space, which is ideal for large panels, dancing, performances, group work and more. The Cinema also has 125 fixed seats, but up to 176 people can be accommodated with extra rows of chairs.







## THE CONFERENCE ROOMS

The National Museum's conference rooms overlook the Museum's bright, beautiful entrance hall. Within the 56 m<sup>2</sup>, you will find modern, built-in and easily accessible AV equipment to suit all your presentation needs.

The conference rooms can seat 40 people in rows of chairs, 34 people seated at long tables, 25 people seated in a U-formation, and 30 people seated in a square. The conference rooms can also be used as a group breakout space for events hosted in the Ballroom, the Hall, and the Cinema.



Nearest parking facility is BLOX parking, a 6 minute walk from the National Museum, or in Industriens Hus, which is an 8 minute walk.

# Train, Bus and Metro

10 minute walk from Copenhagen Central Station to the National Museum.

#### Bus

Take Bus 2A, which runs every 8 minutes from Copenhagen Central Station, and get off at Stormgade. From Stormgade, it is less than 5 minutes to walk to the National Museum.

#### Metro

Nearest station is Gammel Strand, about a 5 minute walk to the National Museum.
